IN THE BOOK OF ACTS TODAY WE READ OF PETER AND THE APOSTLES PROCLAIMING BOLDLY THAT JESUS DIED AND YET IS RISEN FROM THE DEAD. AND IT IS BECAUSE OF JESUS AND HIS RESURRECTION THAT WE HAVE FORGIVENESS OF ALL OUR SINS.



Sometimes at Easter we decorate eggs. Easter eggs can be a symbol of the resurrection or new life. The symbol of a chick coming from an egg can remind us that Jesus came forth from the tomb on the third day. And he gives us new life and a "living hope" just like Peter writes in our reading from 1 Peter 1:3-9

Psalm 148 is a psalm of thanks that excites and calls all creation to praise God. Easter and the celebration of Jesus resurrection reminds us to praise and give God our thanks.

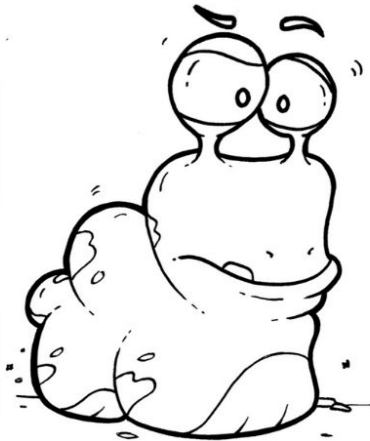


Gumps is excited about the message of Jesus resurrection.

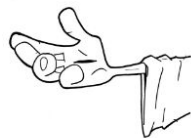
